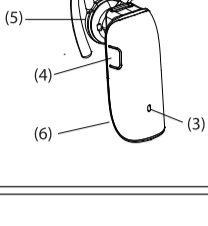
## Quick Reference Guide

**Jabees beetleS is a Bluetooth Convertible Music Headset supports A2DP, Multipoint and Voice Prompt in English and Chinese.**

### Overview of beetleS:

- (1) Earhook
- (2) Charging jack/audio jack
- (3) LED light
- (4) MF Button
- (5) Speaker
- (6) Microphone



### CHARGING THE BATTERY

1. Plug the USB charging cable into the headset.
2. Plug the other end of the USB charging cable into the charger with USB port or PC.
3. The red indicator on the headset will be on during charging.
4. When the battery is fully charged (approximately 3 hours), the red indicator light will turn off and the blue indicator light will turn on.

#### Warning

- You must only use the charger or USB cable that is included.
- You must recharge the headset if it has been not used for more than 12 months.
- Make sure that your headset is fully charged for at least 4 hours before initial use.

### MULTIFUNCTIONAL BUTTON

Pairing, Answer / End / Reject / Transfer calls, Voice dialing, Redial, Play Music, Pause Music.

### TURNING HEADSET ON / OFF

#### To turn the headset on:

Press and hold the MF Button for 3 seconds and you will hear the voice prompt.

#### To turn the headset off:

Press and hold the MF Button for 3 seconds and you will hear the voice prompt.

### PAIRING THE HEADSET

You are required to pair the headset with your mobile phone once before using it.

1. Press and hold the MF Button for 5 seconds. You will see the LED light turns on in solid blue and hear the voice prompt.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your mobile phone.
3. Set your phone to discover 'beatleS' and follow the instruction.
4. If your phone asks for passkey or PIN-code, confirm with "0000".
5. You can hear the voice prompt when beetleS is connected with your phone successfully.

#### Note:

1. If your beetleS has not been paired to any mobile phones in the range, beetleS will go into pairing mode automatically after around 30 seconds.
2. If beetleS is not in pairing mode, your mobile phone won't find the headset.
3. If no pairing is possible for a period of time (approximately 3 minutes), the headset will automatically leave pairing mode and go to the idle mode. You may need to start all over again.

### PAIRING THE HEADSET WITH THE SECOND MOBILE PHONE

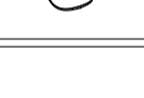
beatleS supports multipoint. This means beetleS can be paired and connected with 2 mobile phones at the same time.

1. Pair and connect the headset with the first mobile phone. (Please refer to the 'PAIRING THE HEADSET')
2. Turn off the headset, and then, turn it on again.
3. Press and hold the MF Button to go to the pairing mode.

4. Pair and connect the headset with the second mobile phone. (Please refer to the 'PAIRING THE HEADSET')
5. Turn off the headset after connecting with the second mobile phone. And then turn on the headset again, it will be connected automatically with two mobile phones.

### PLAYING MUSIC

beatleS supports A2DP, this means beetleS can be used to listen to music. When you are listening to the music, you can press the MF Button to play music or make a pause. You can plug in the detachable mono earphone in the audio jack and convert beetleS from mono to stereo easily.



### MAKING CALLS

Once the headset is successfully paired and connected with your mobile phone, you can use it to make and receive calls.

The headset can be used with voice dialing if your mobile phone supports this feature. Please consult your mobile phone's manual for more information.

#### 1. Using voice dialing:

Double click the MF Button twice, wait for a voice prompt and say the name of the person you want to call.

#### 2. Using the phone keys to make a call:

Enter and dial the number on the mobile phone as you normally do. Once the call has been set up, the sound will be transmitted to your headset automatically.

#### 3. Redial:

Press and hold the MF Button for 2 seconds to redial the last number you called.

### ANSWERING / ENDING /REJECTING CALLS

When the headset is turned on and there is an incoming call, you will hear a musical tone (subject to the mobile phone feature).

- Press the MF Button to answer the call.
- Press the MF Button to end the call.
- Press the MF Button for 2 seconds to reject the call.

### ANSWERING/REJECTING CALLS WHEN LISTENING TO MUSIC

If there is an incoming call when you are listening to music from your phone or PC or other Bluetooth enabled devices, the music will be paused automatically. You can press the MF Button to answer the call and press and hold the MF Button for 2 seconds to reject the call.

### PUT THE CALL ON HOLD

#### In call state:

Press and hold the MF Button for 2 seconds to put the active call on hold.

#### In call wait state:

Press and hold the MF Button for 2 seconds to put the current call on hold and accept the call waiting.

Press the MF Button once to end the call waiting.

### TRANSFERRING CALLS

#### To transfer a call to the mobile phone and back:

During both incoming call and outgoing call state, you can double click the MF Button twice to transfer the call to the mobile phone.

If you want to transfer the call back to the headset, double click the MF Button twice again. Some mobile phones may require more confirmation.

### ADJUST THE VOLUME

You can adjust the volume in your mobile phone or other Bluetooth-enabled devices.

### WHEN THE BATTERY IS LOW

The beetleS voice prompt function will tell you the battery status. When you hear the voice prompt of low battery, you should charge the headset.

### LANGUAGE SELECTION

Turn on beetleS, make sure it is not connected with any Bluetooth devices. Double click the MF Button to switch the language from Chinese to English or from English to Chinese.

### TO DO A FACTORY RESET

1. Make sure beetleS is turned off.
2. Press and hold the MF Button for 8 seconds and you will hear the voice prompt, the LED light turns on in solid blue and then turns off.
3. Factory reset is completed.

### CONNECTING WITH A PC

You are allowed to connect the headset with a Bluetooth-enabled PC that is supported with headset and/or handsfree profile.

Please refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth-enabled PC for set up information.
