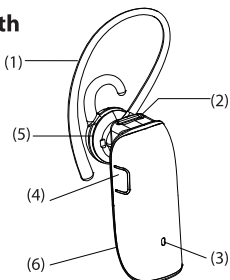

### Jabees Beatle is a V3.0 Bluetooth Mono Headset.

#### Overview of Beatle:

- (1) Earhook
- (2) Micro USB charging port
- (3) LED light
- (4) MF Button (Multifunction Button)
- (5) Speaker
- (6) Microphone



### CHARGING THE BATTERY

1. Plug the AC charger into the headset.
  2. Plug the other end of the AC charger into your wall power socket.
  3. The red indicator on the headset will be on.
  4. When the battery is fully charged, the red indicator will turn off and the blue indicator will turn on.
- The charging takes approximately 1.5 hours.

#### Important

- For the first time use, please charge the headset fully before using.
- You can also charge the headset by the authorized USB cable.

### MULTIFUNCTIONAL BUTTON

Power on/ off, Pairing, Answer / End / Reject / Transfer calls, Voice dialing, Redial.

### TURNING HEADSET ON / OFF

#### To turn the headset on:

Press and hold the MF-button for 3 seconds, The blue LED light flashes with a prompt tone. The headset is now turned on.

#### To turn the headset off:

Press and hold the MF-button for 3 seconds, The blue LED light flashes with a prompt tone. The headset is now turned off.

### PAIRING THE HEADSET

You are required to pair the headset with your mobile phone once before using it.

1. Press and hold the MF button for 5 seconds until you see the LED light in solid blue to go into the pairing mode.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your mobile phone.

3. Set your phone to discover 'Beatle' and follow the instruction.
4. If your phone asks for passkey or PIN-code, confirm with '0000' (4 zero).
5. When the phone and "Beatle" are paired and connected, you will hear the prompt tone.

#### Note:

1. If "Beatle" is not in pairing mode, your mobile phone won't find the headset. Please set the headset into pairing mode before making your mobile phone search for "Beatle".
2. If no pairing is possible for a period of time (approximately 2 minutes), the headset will automatically leave pairing mode with blue indicator light flashes, About 2 minutes later, the headset will automatically turn off.

### MAKING CALLS

Once the headset is successfully paired and connected with your mobile phone, you can use it to make and receive calls. The headset can be used with voice dialing if your mobile phone supports this feature. Please consult your mobile phone's manual for more information.

#### 1. Using voice dialing:

Short press the MF-button once, waiting for a prompt tone and say the name of the person you want to call.

#### 2. Using the phone keys to make a call:

Enter and dial the number on the mobile phone as you normally do. Once the call has been set up, the sound will be transmitted to your headset automatically.

#### 3. Redial:

Press and hold the MF-button for 2 seconds to redial the last number you called.

### ANSWERING / ENDING /REJECTING CALLS

When the headset is turned on and there is an incoming call, you will hear a prompt tone.

- Press the MF-button once to answer the call.
- Press the MF-button once to end the call.
- Press and hold the MF-button for 2 seconds to reject the call.

### PUT THE CALL ON HOLD

#### In call state:

Press and hold the MF-button for 2 seconds to put the active call on hold.

#### In call wait state:

Press and hold the MF-button for 2 seconds to put the current call on hold and accept the call waiting. Press and hold the MF-button for 2 seconds to resume to the first call.

### TRANSFERRING CALLS

#### To transfer a call to the mobile phone and back:

During both incoming call and outgoing call state, you can short press the MF-button twice to transfer the call to the mobile phone. If you want to transfer the call back to the headset, short press the MF-button twice again. Some mobile phones may require more confirmation.

### ADJUST THE VOLUME

You can increase/ decrease the volume by increasing/decreasing the volume of your mobile phone. The volume of your headset will be adjusted automatically. Please consult your mobile phone's manual for more information.

### WHEN THE BATTERY IS LOW

The red indicator light will flash when the battery is low. At the same time, you can hear the prompt tone. At this time, please charge your headset.

### CONNECTING WITH A PC OR PDA

You are allowed to connect the headset with a Bluetooth-enabled PC or PDA. Please refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth-enabled PC or PDA for setup information.
